PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

As we walked along the trail we heard a rustling sound in the trees above us. We looked up and saw a hawk landing in a nearby tree. Looking again, we saw that the trees around us were filled with hawks preparing to call it a day on a late winter afternoon in Oklahoma. It filled us with wonder to see hundreds of these magnificent birds roosting on the bare tree branches. It was December 29 and Claudia and I had made our semi-annual pilgrimage to Sulphur, Oklahoma for the beauty of the Chickasaw National Recreation Area, which is located just two hours north of Dallas and the two Year Round trails which start at the Travertine Nature Center. There is a 10K trail around Veterans Lake, a short drive from the Center, and a second trail with your choice of a 10K or 14K trail which starts at the Nature Center. Both routes are on wooded trails and highlight the beauty of this part of central Oklahoma. Each time we have surveyed our members you have unanimously agreed that your favorite walks take place on wooded trails in wilderness areas. Sulphur, Oklahoma is just such a place and is worth every minute of the time it takes to make the trip. To get to Sulphur, drive north on I-35 to either exit 51 or 55 and drive through Davis on Hwy 7 to Sulphur. (Cooper Lake in Sulphur Springs, TX, also, has a great wooded trail walk.) Don't miss either of these walks.

Welcome to the new *Dallas Trekkers Newsletter* with a larger format, bigger type and electronic distribution. We have many exciting activities planned for 2003. The first is the Club's annual **Holiday Party and Volunteer Recognition Dinner**, which will be at the El Fenix on **Tuesday, January 14**. The fun begins at 6:30 PM and make sure you bring a White Elephant gift for our annual gift exchange. The **White Elephant Exchange** game is always a lot of fun. An important part of our annual holiday party is the recognition of our enthusiastic volunteers without whom the club could not function. The club has two different **Worker Bee Awards** for those who have given their time in support of our sport. The first, the Blue Worker Bee patch, is awarded to everyone who gives between ten and 25 hours on behalf of our organization. This can be anything from working at an event to laying out a trail, making phone calls, being a YRE or scheduled event

walk director, designing a brochure, printing or distributing brochures, publicizing one of our events in other ways, writing an article or taking photos for the newsletter, leading a group walk or attending club EC meetings. If you have done some other service for the club that is not mentioned here, then please by all means add it to your hours. The only thing that doesn't count is the time you spend doing one of our walks, unless it is a guided walk and you happen to be the leader. The second award is the Gold Worker Bee patch. The gold patch is awarded to everyone who volunteers more than 25 hours on behalf of the club. **If you have worked enough time during 2002 to earn one of these awards, please contact Ken King or myself so you can be added to the list.** A big "thank you" goes out to everyone who gave of his or her time this past year.

An added bonus for those who attend our Holiday Party. To reduce our Trekker clothing inventory, at the January party we will hold a special **make a donation for the fair market value of one of our Trekker specialty items and receive a second item of like value.** We have about 35 shirts (\$22 Sweatshirts, \$17 Polo Golf Shirts and \$12 T-Shirts), 22 pairs of socks (\$6 Thorlo) and 3 hats (\$8 each) ready for your donation. Mark your calendar for our eight scheduled events during 2003 and **don't forget to schedule your vacation so you can take part in the AVA Convention in late June in Colorado Springs.** Visit the AVA Convention web site at: www.avaconvention.org. February 8 we will hold a walk out of **Medical City** in Dallas that will go along White Rock Creek. March 15 we'll walk out of **Pilot Knoll Park** in Highland Village. April 5 we return to **Huffhines Recreation Center** in Richardson and May 3 we're back in uptown Dallas on the **KATY Trail and along Turtle Creek**. June 7 we will hold a walk in **Waxahachie**. This will be a great time to also take the Trekkers' new **Waxahachie Year Round** if you miss the **Kick off Walk** coming up on January 18. Workers, don't forget to request a couple of hours off or a day of leave on Friday, July 11, when we go below ground again with a return to the **Dallas Underground**. If you did not take this walk in 2001 you missed the unique and enjoyable experience of an air-conditioned walk in the middle of July. On September 20 get out your DART tickets for our annual **DART and Walk** with four trails along the DART rail line. We end the year with a return to the **LBJ Grasslands** near Decatur. This walk revisits a trail that members of the Dallas Trekkers laid out on the late 1980's. If you have any ideas for other places where we can schedule an event or set up another year round event, please contact John Ferguson, Ken King, Jim Ross or me.

The year 2003 also brings major changes to our **Year Round trails**. We're putting several trails on the shelf for a while, sending one to the East Texas Trekkers and starting three new walks. The **Downtown Dallas, White Rock Lake, Denton** and **Richardson** walks will be back, joined by a new second walk in **Carrollton West** and **revised Carrollton East** walk. For those who took the very first Carrollton walk you will remember that it used to go past a very nice lake west of Josey Lane and visit an historic cemetery. They're back on the new **Carrollton West** walk. Also added this year, are walks in **Duncanville** and **Waxahachie**. In 1999 the club did a series of very popular walks out of Duncanville's Armstrong Park. We updated the trail that went through a series of very nice parks and beginning in 2003 we're making it a Year Round. Our final new walk this year is in Waxahachie, site of the best-attended walk ever held by the Dallas Trekkers. If you've never visited this beautiful town south of Dallas you're in for a rare treat. The exquisite courthouse, historic old houses and tree-lined streets make this one of the nicest places to walk in Texas. Please take these new walks that we proudly present to the Dallas community and make sure you walk your old favorites as well. Remember you can take each YRE anywhere in the United States once each half of the year for event credit and as many times as you wish for distance credit. (For a complete listing of all YREs in the United States, visit the AVA web site at www.ava.org or our site at www.dallastrekkers.org to download brochures for walks that are a days drive from Texas that clubs have made available for us to post on our web site.) The Carrollton, Richardson Whole Foods Market and White Rock Lake YREs have **weekly group walks** and many of our serious walkers are **racking up lots of kilometers** each week while **socializing and exercising with other club members**. There's still time to get into shape to walk at the higher altitudes in the Rockies at the AVA Convention in June. Check the Bulletin Board on our web site for the latest updates for scheduled times and dates.

Don't forget that the **cost for walk credit in 2003 will be \$3.00**. All members of the Dallas Trekkers may purchase new **Frequent Walker Coupons** for \$2.50 apiece in blocks of 15 coupons (\$37.50), which are good on any Dallas Trekker Year Round event. These personalized, money-saving coupons are non-transferrable, but do not expire. The Dallas Trekkers will honor any coupon that was purchased in previous years despite the cost increase so please feel free to use up your coupons when taking our year round events.
